## MUSIC THROUGH THE YEARS

One of the first challenges was creating a new hymn book for all. The three churches (Methodist, Congregational and Presbyterian) took five years to create the blue "Hymnary." This has been replaced several times until the "Voices United" we use today. The following are two examples of early hymns:

# 1870's

The church's one foundation is Jesus Christ her Lord; She is His new creation by water and the word. From heaven He came and sought her to be His holy bride. With his own blood He bought her and for her life He died.

## 1780's

O for a Thousand Tongues to sing my dear Redeemer's praise The glories of my God and King the triumphs of His grace.
