Today in our continuing series of stories about the history of the United Church we celebrate Decoration Day at Greenwood Cemetery to honour the veterans.

The United Church in Waterford and nationally, were deeply involved in the war effort. One example of interest to us is a quote from the Official Board minutes from January 26, 1943.

- "After the annual congregational meeting, a radio was switched on and we all heard broadcasted the important news of Prime Minister Winston Churchill and President Roosevelt's conference in Casablanca".
- In 1943 no lunch was served at the Annual Meeting because of rationing, A member of the Women's Association offered her rationing coupons so that tea could be served at the W.A. meeting.

Many other changes were to come!
