The light of your love shows us who our neighbours are, and it also shows up all the barriers we have raised; and all the excuses that we have rehearsed, for not loving as you love. Forgive us, and set us free.

Loving God – we know that you are love – and that those who abide in love abide in you and you in them. We would abide in you, and have you abide in us. Help us see the specific and concrete things that we can do to show love to one another – and grant us the strength to do these things – the courage - and the will – for many forces seek to deter us from doing good, many forces attempt to destroy what you would build in us and through us.

Gracious Spirit, search our hearts too this day and intercede for us; speak for us before the throne of heaven. Grant we pray the blessing we ask for those whom we name now before you in our hearts ..........
