## CHRISTMAS EVE COMMUNION



### INVITATION TO THE LORD'S TABLE

This is the Table of the Lord. Come, like Mary, placing your trust in God to help you through whatever lies ahead. Come, like Joseph, relying not on the law or reputation, or anything other than the love of God. Come, like the angels, lifting your voice in praise of God, spreading peace to all the earth. Come, like the shepherds, called from work to the joy of worship. Come, like the Magi, from all corners of the globe, to greet the Christ child. This is the Table of the Lord. Come, all you who long to meet God here, for you are very welcome.

### THE PRAYER OF GREAT THANKSGIVING

The Lord be with you.

**And with you also.**

Lift up your hearts.

**We lift them up to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

**It is right to give our thanks and praise.**

It is right and our greatest duty and joy, Gracious God, Creator of heaven and earth, to praise you with heart, mind, soul and strength. You created light out of nothing and formed us in your image, calling us to love and serve you, and live in peace in the world you love. When we turned from you, you did not turn from us. You offered us a word of liberation through the prophets, guiding us back to follow your way. And so with choirs of angels and archangels, with shepherds and saints, prophets and disciples, with your people from every time and place, we join the whole creation to lift our hearts in joyful praise:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

We give you thanks, holy God, for sending your beloved Son Jesus into the world. Born in the night, he is the Light of the World. Born in the humility of a stable, he is filled with majesty. Though poor, he is rich in mercy and grace.

Though rejected by the world, he welcomes all to his side. Though dying on the cross, he brings new life. In rising from the grave, he promises to be with us always. And when he was raised to your glory, you sent your Holy Spirit to keep us united with him and one another. Remembering these wondrous things, we proclaim the mystery of our faith:

**Christ has died. Christ has risen. Christ will come again.**

Merciful God, pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered at this holy table, and on these gifts of bread and wine. May they be for us the body and blood of our Lord Jesus. Nourished by them, may we become the body of Christ at work in the world, made new and redeemed by his blood. Through Christ, with Christ, in Christ, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory are yours now and forever.

As our Lord taught us, we now pray:

### THE LORD'S PRAYER

#### THE STORY OF THE TABLE

The Lord Jesus, on the night of his arrest, took bread, and after giving thanks to God, he broke it and said, "This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

In the same way, he took the cup after supper, saying "This is the new covenant sealed in my blood. Whenever you drink it, do it in remembrance of me."

*(Breaking the bread)* This bread is the body of Christ, broken for you.

*(Lifting the cup)* This is the blood of Christ, shed for you.

Every time we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the birth, death, and resurrection of our Lord, until he comes again.

(Communion will be by intinction, people come to the communion station take bread and dip it in the cup then return to their seat. All are welcome. We will serve those unable to come to the front.)

#### PRAYER AFTER COMMUNION

Eternal and ever present God, in gratitude for this meal in which you have given yourself to us, we give ourselves to you. Take us out this night to walk in your light, to follow the Prince of Peace, to lead lives filled with your love, feeding a hungry world, and sharing your Good News with those we meet for the sake of Jesus Christ, born in wonder for the sake of the world you love. Amen.
